  - Impression of the book by its cover title etc, what the book actually is.
  - Your favourite parts or quotes or characters from the book.
  - Most importantly, your personal views about the book after reading it.
- 4) Read the poem, 'I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings' and prepare a **fictitious conversation** between any two caged animals.
