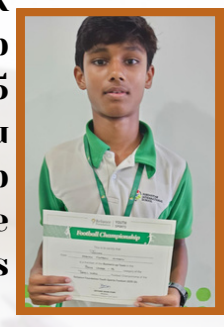
BOOK OF RECORDS

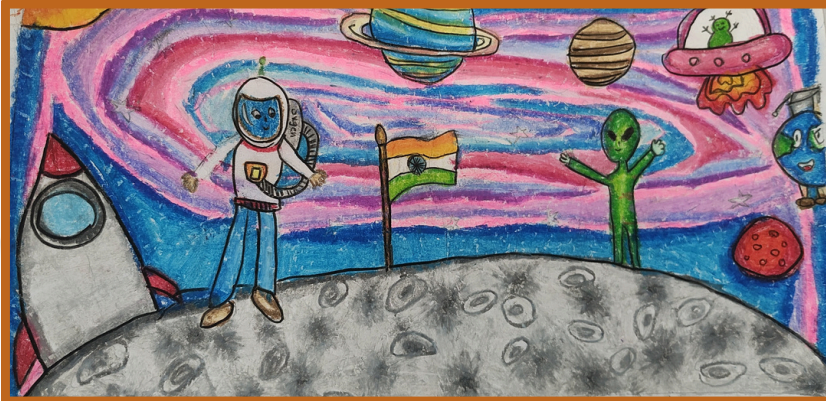
