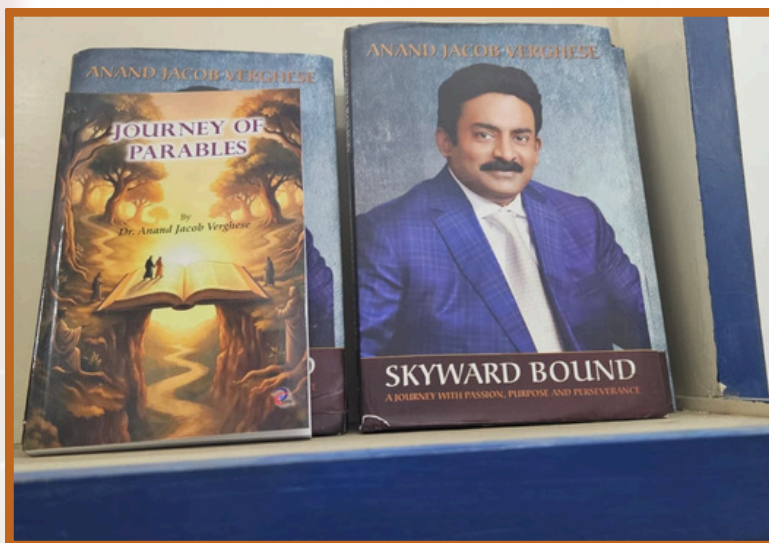
MERAKI COMPETITION

BILLABONG INTERNATIONAL INTERSCHOOL COMPETITION



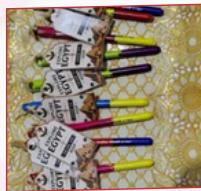
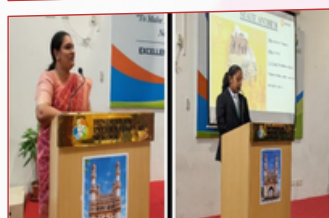
