Mountains tall with peaks that soar, Echo secrets from days of yore. Flowers bloom in meadows wide, Painting fields in hues untied.



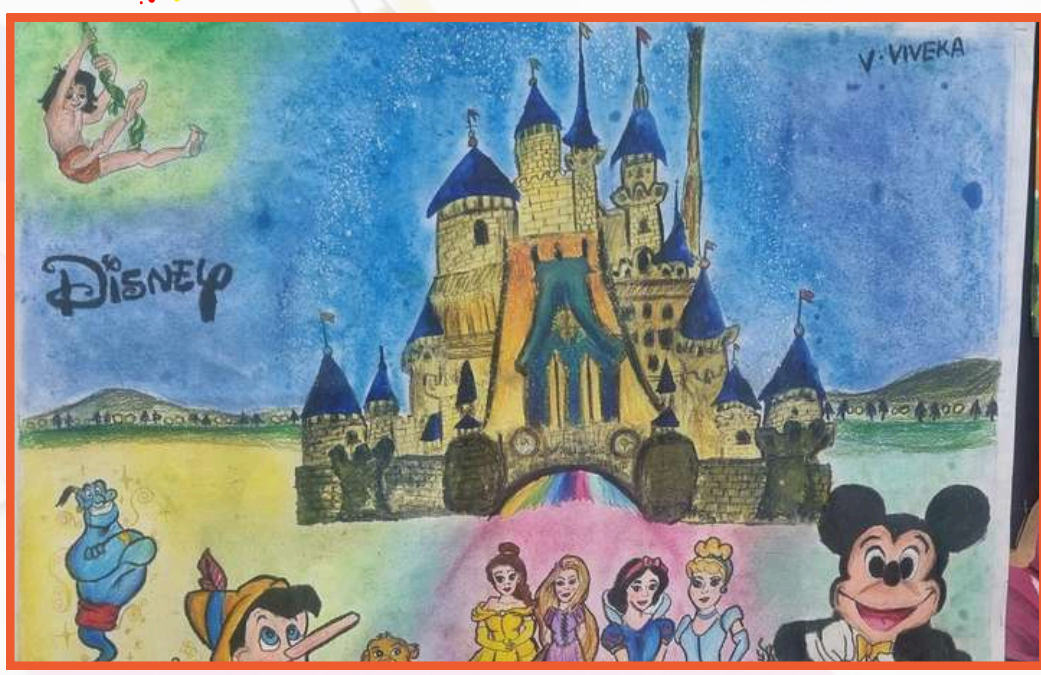
Birds in flight, a graceful dance, Underneath the vast expanse. Nature's beauty pure and free, A timeless gift for all to see.
