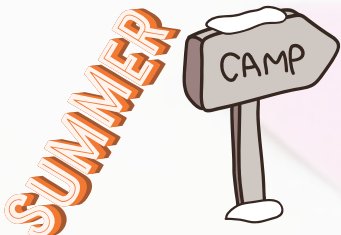


SUMMER CAMP

RAMADAN CELEBRATION

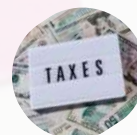

POEM MICROBES

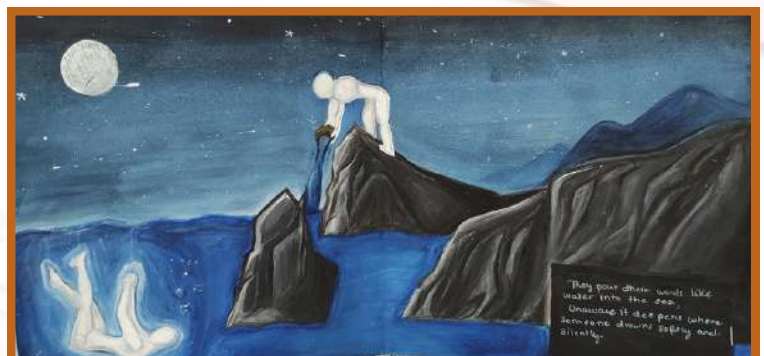
Miracles and mysteries surround them,
