The launch event provided an excellent opportunity for students to witness history in the making and to dream of contributing to future space missions.

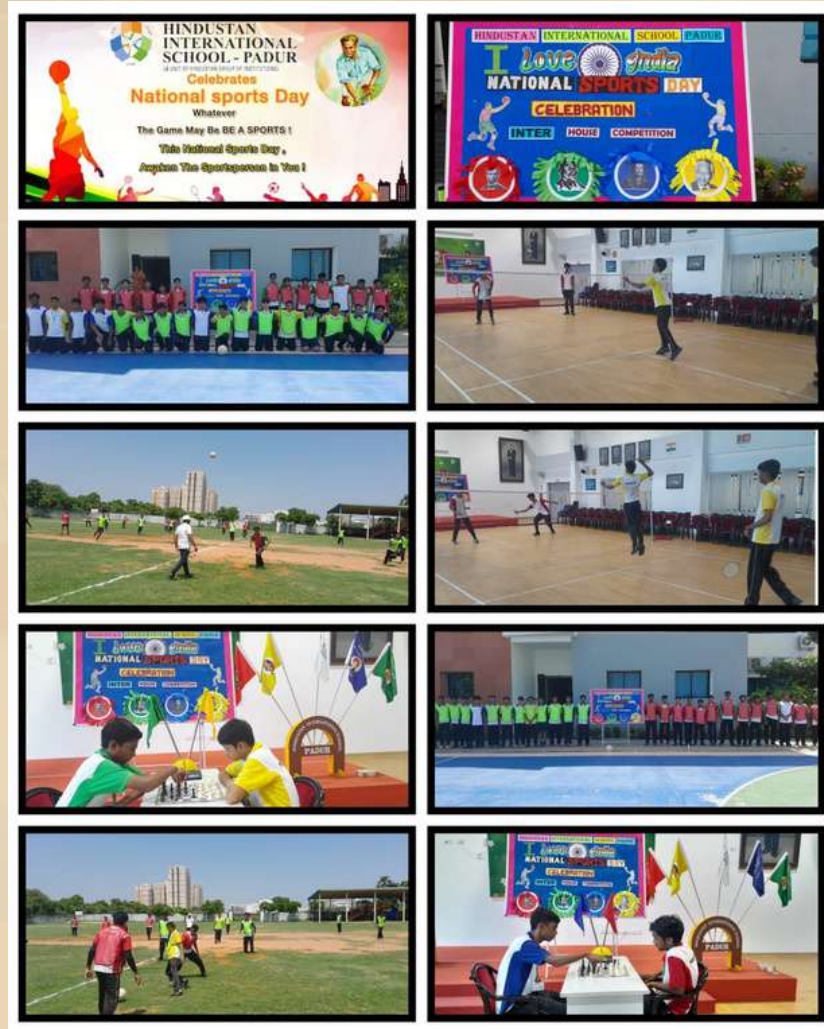
POSCO COMMITTEE MEETING – 25 Aug 2023

Mr Johnson Mathew, Dean of academics headed over the meeting along with the committee members.

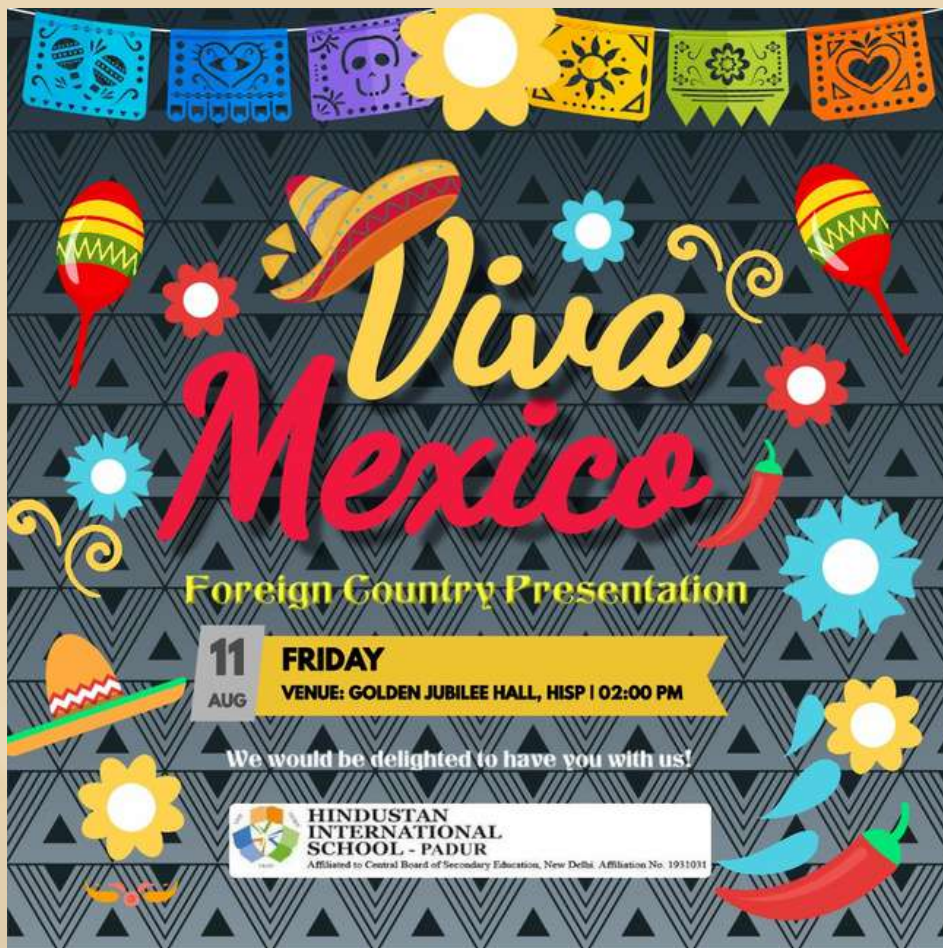
NATIONAL SPORTS DAY – 29 Aug 2023

As we look forward to upcoming cultural and sports events, I encourage everyone to continue giving their utmost, just as we always have.

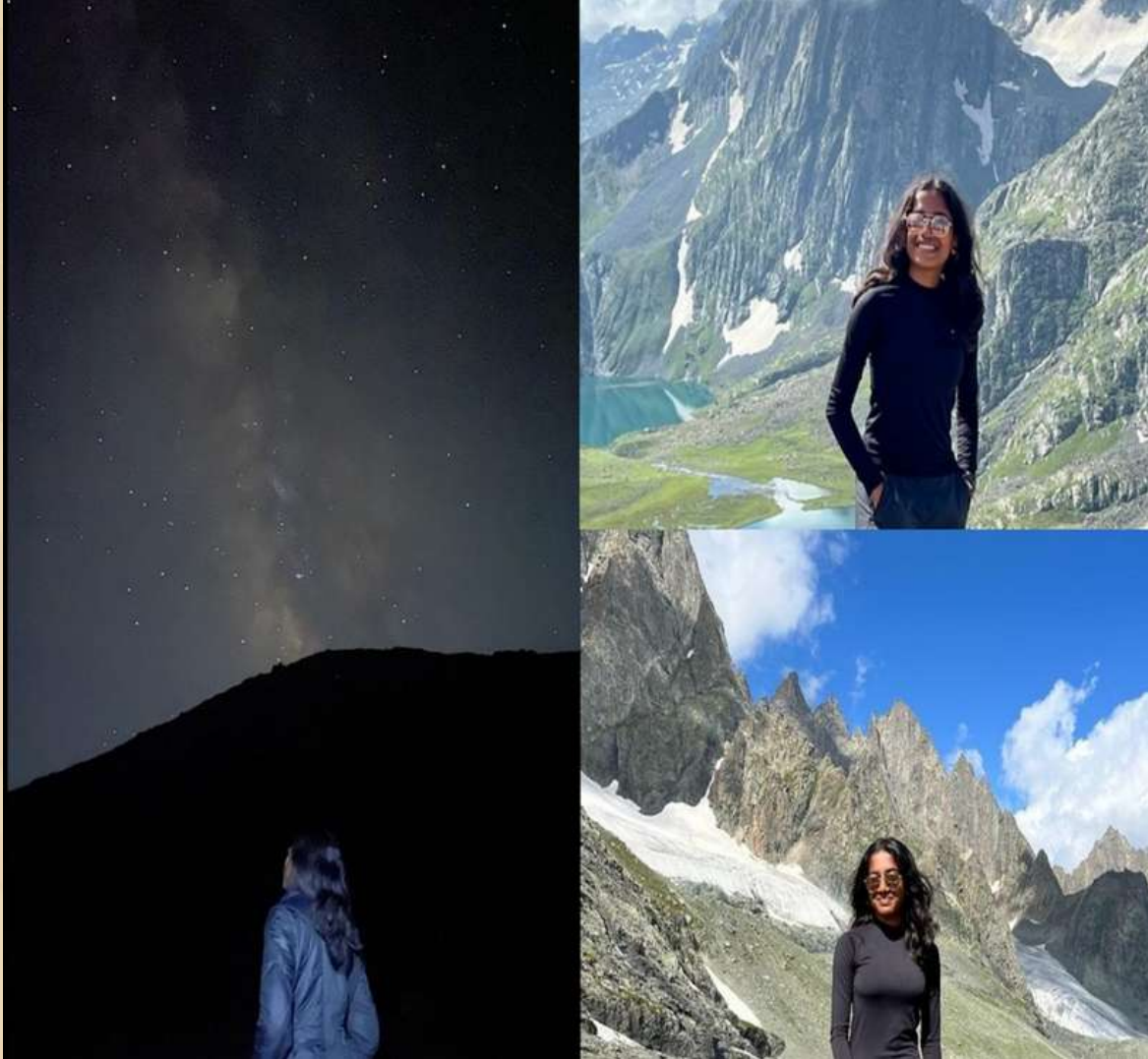

90 km over six days, a 13,850 ft summit, and complete obliviousness to what I had signed myself up for. Being my first, I had no idea what to expect from the 'Kashmir Great Lakes(KGL)' trek. All I saw were the words 'difficulty level 3' and 'most beautiful trek of India'.. and I was sold.



This trek was the most physically and mentally strenuous challenge I've encountered. I spent six days surrounded by endless valleys, sprawling mountains, cloudless blue skies and the serenity of the still, teal lakes. From walking across glaciers, climbing 80-degree inclines on slippery pebbles, huge stretches of boulders and a 15-kilometre average everyday, KGL was the most exhilarating experience of my life. Starting out, I found myself constantly questioning why I signed up for this- until I found out what it felt like to reach the summit. The feeling of accomplishment that reaching the highest point gives you.. it's indescribable.

Physically, the summit day was the most exhausting with narrow paths and a total distance of 21 kilometres. It was a one-person track that you could barely even call a trail. To beat the crowd and the heat, we woke up at 3.30am every day, and started trekking by 5 am after unpitching our tents and warming up. While the nights dropped to one or two degrees, our trek days were usually scorching after the sun came up as there was no tree cover, owing to the high altitude.

Quitting wasn't an option. All we could do was focus on the next two steps and the chorus of 'chaliye chaliye' from our trek guides. This whole experience taught me about mindset and how easily it could change my attitude about what needed to be done.

To be environment-friendly, our trek leader gave us 'eco-bags' and we collected plastic waste left by other trekkers. Our group of twenty-two collected more than 80 kg of plastic throughout the trek, helping it become a green trail.

Words can never do justice to an experience like this, especially not to the huge expanses of stars we saw every night. We were lucky to have clear skies all through the trek, and we could see the milky way crystal clear. With the towering mountains each morning and the stunning skies each night, KGL was an immensely humbling experience. It's something I'll never forget. While this was my first trek- the impact that it had on me.. well,

'Yeh dil maange more'.
